
I am requesting community project funding for Casa Grande Union High School District; Teacher Housing and Student Learning Project in fiscal year 2026. The entity to receive funding for this project is Casa Grande Union High School District located at 1362 N. Casa Grande Ave Casa Grande, AZ 85122.

Funds will be used to construct prefabricated teacher housing units on existing district land by utilizing high school career and technical education and construction students to help construct the homes with guidance and support from local registered housing contractors.
