I am requesting community project funding for the Sierra Vista Buffalo Soldier Trail Pavement Replacement in fiscal year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Sierra Vista, located at 401 Giulio Cesare Ave, Sierra Vista AZ 85635.

Funds will be used for the design and reconstruction of the Buffalo Soldier Trail (BST). This roadway is regionally significant and is critical to the community and the neighboring military installation for emergency response, commerce, and services. BST is a federally classified Minor Arterial Roadway connecting the State Highway System at two locations, State Route 90 and State Route 92. Previous phases of this project were selected in the FY24 and FY26 appropriations cycle and is currently moving forward in the process. This is a valuable use of taxpayer funds because this roadway serves as the gateway to the City of Sierra Vista and Fort Huachuca Army Installation with nearly 20,000 vehicles a day utilizing this roadway.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by e funding provided is for purposes authorized by 23 USC 133(b).
