Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting community project funding for East Avenue Flood Mitigation and Pedestrian Safety Improvements in fiscal year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Town of Duncan located, at 506 Old West Highway Duncan, AZ 85534.

The funding would be used to address severe recurring flooding and pedestrian safety hazards along East Avenue, a critical local roadway located immediately south of U.S. Highway 70. During moderate rainfall events, stormwater runoff from Highway 70 and surrounding areas flows downhill into East Avenue, where the lack of drainage infrastructure causes water to accumulate rapidly. Flooding frequently reaches depths of three feet or greater, preventing pedestrian access, limiting vehicular travel, damaging adjacent properties, and degrading the roadway surface. The proposed project will reconstruct approximately 2,400 linear feet of East Avenue and install critical stormwater and pedestrian infrastructure. This is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds as these improvements will significantly reduce flooding, improve pedestrian safety, and ensure reliable access for residents, businesses, and emergency services during storm events.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by 42 U.S.C. 5305(a)(1) and 42 U.S.C. 5305(a)(2).
